SCHEDULE OF TRADE RELATED FEES AND LEVIES ON INTER-STATE MOVEMENT OF GOODS

Pursuant to the provisions of Revenue collection task force law of 1985 Part 8, section 86 sub-sections (v) which gives the Commissioner the right to prescribe fees and charges payable and here as it relates haulage and commerce fees in Anambra State.

Below are the prescribed fees by the Ministry as approved by the Commissioner:

All payments should be made directly to state government designated agents at the loading location.

After products have been loaded at the designated warehouse, the loaded vehicle begins its transit out of the state.

- At the exit borders of the state, a haulage / commerce fee is paid to designated agents.
- The approved tariff is outlined below.

HAULAGE AND COMMERCE FEES:

Small Truck (Pick up)	1,000
Truck with 6 Tyres (Dyna)	1,500
Truck with 6 Tyres (911)	3,000
Truck with 10- Tyres	4,000
Trailers with 12 Tyres	4,000

These trade fees are computed on per entry / per vehicle size basis.
