

WATER CONNECTION GUIDELINE (FOR DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL, GOVERNMENT, INDUSTRIAL AND INSTITUTIONAL USE)

In Accordance with the Provisions of the Anambra State Water Supply Law 2015

All individuals and organizations in Anambra State can apply for water connection through the following process:

Step 1	<p>Start your application by using the process below</p> <p>Write an application letter addressed to: The Director, Water Resources Department, Ministry of Power and Water Resources, Government House, Awka, Anambra State, Nigeria. (Endeavour to attach a functional email address in the application letter)</p>
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Step 2	<p>A reply will be sent to the applicant in the email address provided.</p> <p>Processing Timeline: We aim to process submitted applications for water connections within 21 Working Days</p>
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Step 3	<p>The applicant is to pay the connection fee to the account designated here at any bank of choice according to the rates provided below as approved by the State Executive Council, February 2020:</p> <p>Anambra State Government Pay Direct 61001001-12040223</p>

Step 4	The applicant is to forward evidence of payment to the Director, Water Resources Department, Ministry of Power and Water Resources,
	The director assigns the applicant to the water supply service provider covering their jurisdiction as approved .

Step 5	<p>The water supply service provider will reticulate a supply point within 100 metres of the applicant's property.</p> <p>Timeline: The reticulation timeline for applicants who have paid the water connection fee is within 42 Working Days</p>
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Step 6	The applicant is to make a connection from the reticulated supply point provided by the water supply service provider at their own discretion or in accordance with a private arrangement with the service provider.
